

BMW CCA Membership Continues Growth Trend A Welcome Turnaround After Years of Decline

Reports of the BMW Car Club of America's death have been greatly exaggerated. Or have they? Two years ago I attended a National Congress where senior leadership of the CCA admitted that the club could become irrelevant. There was a terminal bleeding of members and funds. Trending showed a downward spiral that became evident to even the most optimistic members.



The hard cold facts were annual declines in membership from almost 64,000 primary members in 2008, to 61,000 in 2009, 59,000 in 2010, and finally 58,000 in 2011. This was very bad news by any standard. The Congress felt like we were the crew of the Titanic watching the stern slowly lowering into the North Atlantic and not knowing how to slow or stop the dive. Blaming the economy, BMW marketing, or global warming did not give us a real reasons for the downward trends seen by both BMW CCA and its many regional chapters.

Unlike the Titanic however, we eventually found bouncy. In 2011 membership started to climb. We went from 58,000 to 60,000 in 2012, then 61,000 in 2013. Associate memberships linked to primary members also followed the rebounding trend, supplying an additional 8,000 to the membership rolls.

While the leadership at both the national and regional levels is breathing a collective sigh of relief to some degree, we are not ready to sound the "all clear" signal just yet. There still may be additional dangerous icebergs on the club's horizon but we are crafting plans to avoid them. The first action step entailed surveying our members and we learned 22-25% every year do not renew - mostly because they no longer own a BMW. Sounds like a fair reason, but we all need to counter that negative by enticing new owners into the club.

How do most people learn of the club? According to those surveyed, the answer is, "word of mouth". That means you and I are the best recruiters for our club. So the mission for all of us as club members, is to find friends, co-workers, or fellow BMW owners you might know who could benefit from learning about the CCA and all it has to offer. Everyone will benefit from the new associations and the efforts will help keep this ship above water and on course for a better and exciting BMW future.

few events of the driving season and they both were filled to capacity! Thanks to everyone who made them a huge success.




We have a bunch more events planned for this year's driving season, but if you're on the fence about sign-

hen my 2003 325 recently failed state inspection for "clouded headlights", the dealer presented me with two options - recondition the lenses for \$189 or replace them for \$490. What?!? Neither of these choices appealed to me so I took the "failure" and decided to see about fixing the issue myself.

At one of the big box retailers, I found plenty of DIY kits to choose from. Pricing on them ranged from \$5 to \$60 and were offered by many of the usual suspects (Meguiar's, Mothers, etc.) as well as a number of other suppliers I'd never heard of.

I ended up choosing New Wipe, primarily based on its low cost (\$6) and overall I was very impressed. The process for *both* lenses took only about 30 minutes total, did not require any power tools and the results were fantastic.

If you're ever faced with clouded headlamps, just remember that this is a quick and easy DIY project that will not only restore their luster and clarity, but will also save you lots of money compared to other options. Give it a try and see for yourself!








